

Installation Instructions WAM119 LS-x Crossover Manifold

In The Box:

- 1 Billet Manifold WAM119
- 6 8mm x 65mm Long SSSHCS bolts
- 1 Pair Flange Gaskets WPG119
- 1 -12AN Port Plug
- 1 -16AN Port Plug
- 1 1/8 NPT Port Plug
- 1 3/8 NPT Port Plug
- 2 Contingency Decals

The inlet and outlet fittings must be ordered separately to match your radiator hose types and sizes.



To Do the Job You Will Need:

- Scraper or wire brush
- Brake Cleaner
- Thread sealant; RTV silicone or liquid pipe thread sealant
- Various hex wrenches

Mounting:

Remove stock water pump. Clean and degrease gasket area. The supplied gaskets are prepared with seal enhancing features. No added silicone or sealant is necessary. Apply a small amount of sealant to the threads of the hardware provided. Bolt the crossover manifold in place.

Run all six bolts up snug before tightening to recommended 132 in./ lbs.

On Initial Fill:

Fill the cooling system. Replace fill cap and turn on pump. Remove fill cap and top off coolant level. Recheck level after one heat cycle. Check for leaks.

Beauty Tip:

Your crossover manifold comes to you polished and waxed. Occasional waxing will allow dirt or debris to be wiped right off the pump and offer some protection from UV light (the anodized color on your pump can fade from prolonged exposure to sunlight).
